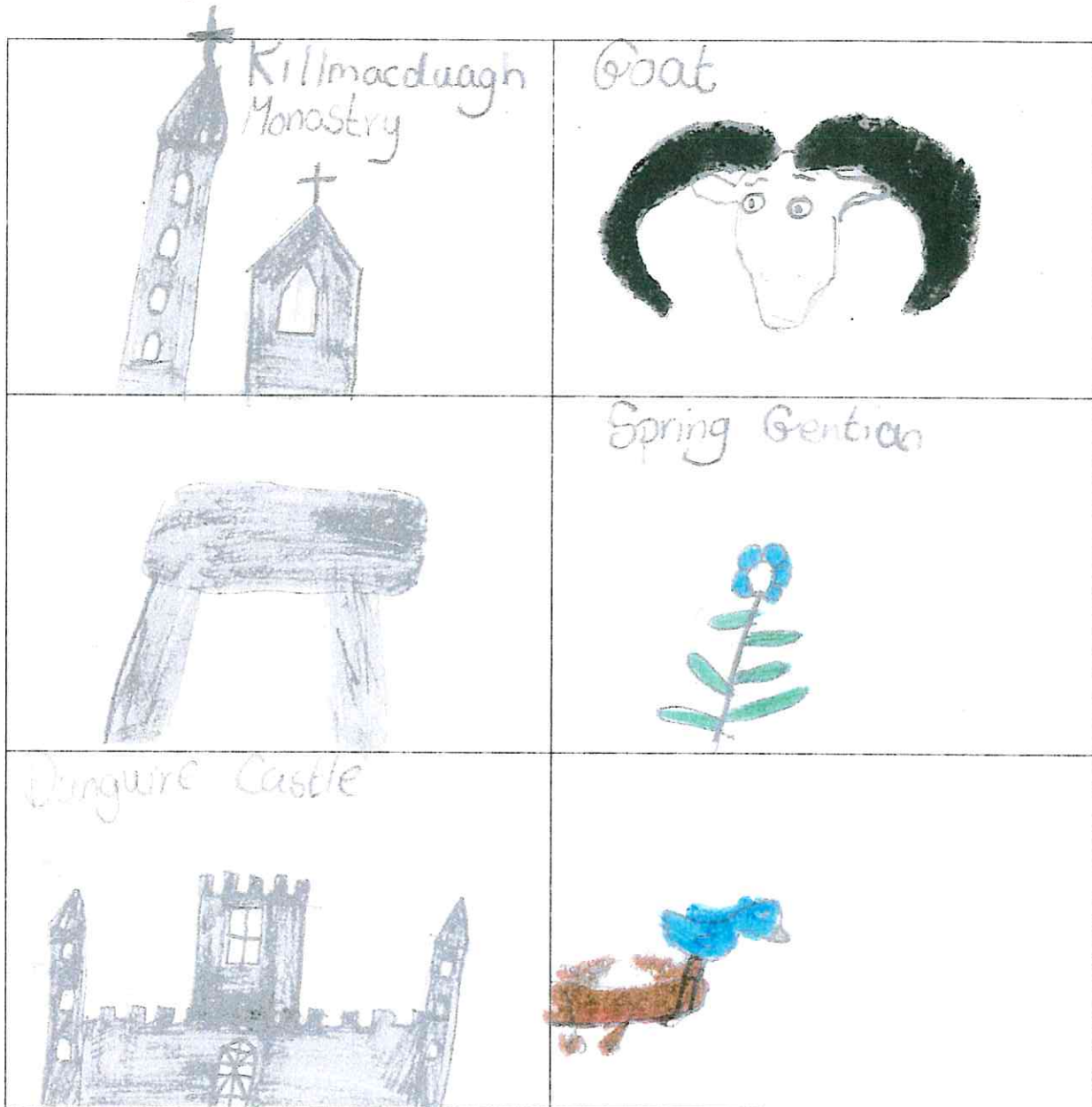

It was formed 350..... million years ago.

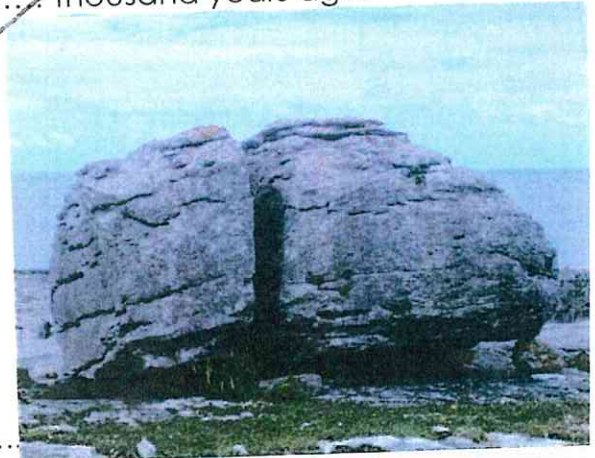
The rock is made up of dead fish and mud.....

Wetlands

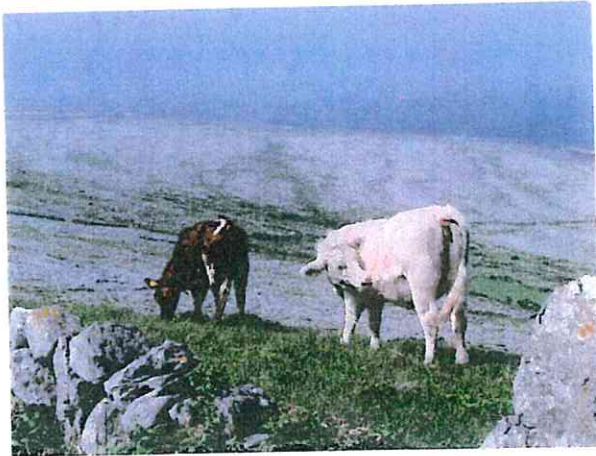
The temporary lakes in the Burren are called Turloughs.

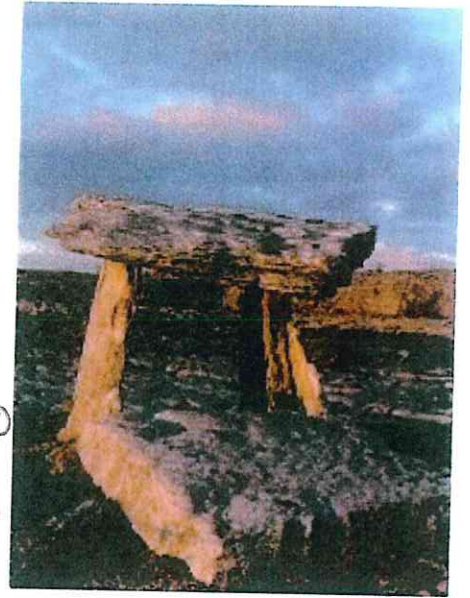
6. ARCHAEOLOGY

The tower house was built about 500 years ago.



The people who lived in the castle worked as farmers
